

<u>West Yorkshire Housing Partnership CEO Meeting – 7 November 2023</u> <u>Summary of Discussions for External Publication</u>

Background

This document summarises the discussions at the West Yorkshire Housing Partnership meeting on 7 November 2023. It will be published for external partners and stakeholders to keep up to date with the work of the Partnership.

Meeting summary

The meeting included the following discussions:

- Chair and Vice-Chair selection Andy Wallhead, Chief Executive of WDH, was selected as the new Chair of the West Yorkshire Housing Partnership, and Nick Atkin, Chief Executive of Yorkshire Housing, was re-selected as the Vice-Chair. The positions will last for 3 years, beginning 1 January 2024.
- West Yorkshire Housing Partnership prospectus the Partnership is developing an influencing document to share with 2024 West Yorkshire Mayoral candidates, setting out the asks and offers of the Partnership.
- Inclusive growth Representatives from the Housing Employment Network North East (HENNE) provided information about their approach, achievements and plans for the future.
- Investment and regeneration Members discussed approaches that the Partnership could take to support planning resource and a project on managing older housing.
- Health, housing and homelessness Members discussed progress on current projects, including dementia ready housing, trauma informed training, autism training and the NHS asthma referral approach related to health and housing.
- Climate emergency Members discussed the approach to progressing projects, including on workforce development.
- West Yorkshire Combined Authority The Combined Authority gave an update on its work, including on the objectives in the Strategic Place Partnership and the consultation on the West Yorkshire Housing Strategy.
- Homes England An update was provided on bulk deals to deliver affordable housing, flexibilities in funding arrangements to support decarbonisation and regeneration, and the changes to shared ownership rent increases.
